

**Taneytown Planning Commission**  
**Minutes from June 30, 2025**

The Taneytown Planning Commission met on June 30, 2025, at 7:30 PM in the City Council chambers. Present were Commission members Myers, Brown, Meade, and Garner. Also present was City Manager Wieprecht. This meeting was open to the public in person.

-Minutes from the April 28, 2025, meeting were approved unanimously following a motion by Commission member Brown which was seconded by Commission member Garner.

**DELEGATION AND ACTION ITEMS**

Kyle Mantua and Corey Groves of Morton Buildings presented the plan for Taneytown's proposed Allendale Lane Public Works facility. The proposed site development will include a 21,200 square foot building to house vehicles and equipment amendment plus office and training spaces for the department. The site also includes a 4,000 square foot salt storage building. Mr. Grover and Mr. Mantua responded to questions from the Commission.

-City manager Wieprecht provided an overview of the ongoing Carroll County Water Resources Element update, sharing summary level information with the Commission. Eventually the Commission will be asked to approve the Taneytown aspects of the plan. City Manager Wieprecht provided a brief update and answered questions regarding ongoing development projects.

-Upon discussion of the ongoing **comprehensive plan update**, the Commission reiterated their desire to have key person interviews completed by the City's consultant.

Commission members commented favorably on the recent Citizen Planning Academy the Carroll County Bureau of Comprehensive Planning conducted.

-The **next Planning Commission** meeting will be held on July 28 at 7:30p.m. With no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:07 PM following unanimous approval of a motion by Commission member Brown, seconded by Commission Member Garner.
