- City Manager Wieprecht reviewed his monthly report which included an update on the Riffles Lane stormwater project and Westview Drive water line replacement. Responding to Council member Tillman about the spike in phosphorous numbers, City Manager Wieprecht advised the wastewater treatment plant has been conducting tests which may have caused the fluctuation, and the drought may also be a factor.

Department Reports:

- Responding to Mayor Pro Tem McCarron, Mayor Miller stated the Police Department car wash will not be canceled due to the voluntary water conservation. Funds were spent months ago in preparation for the event.

Old Business:

- Saubles Addition Annexation – City Manager Wieprecht advised the annexation hearing is scheduled to be part of the June Mayor and Council meeting.
